



Daily TAG Fuels My Faith!

What if the Coronavirus COVID-19 is not a random event that occurred naturally and unexpectedly? What if all of this has been planned for some time? What if it is a test? What if it is a trial run to see how world government leaders would respond to a biological pandemic? What if the official story isn't true? What if it was a human engineered bioweapon? What if the rush to produce vaccines creates vaccines that are not safe for the public and may even cause damage and death? Why are people being censored and removed from the big social media platforms like YouTube and Facebook? What is it that the people who control those companies don't want the world to hear? Why would they be so afraid of the principle of freedom of speech? Why is any idea that questions the official story labeled a conspiracy theory? Is it a hoax? Is it the biggest scam ever perpetrated on the human race? What if lockdowns, quarantines, and isolation are more dangerous and destructive than normal interactions with people and continuing work?

STOP! I NEED TO FUEL MY FAITH!!!

TAG is what I call my Time Alone with God! Many years ago I embraced the practice of writing out my prayers to God in my Prayer Journal. My Prayer Journal entry always starts with the day, date, and time. Then I pour out my heart to God on paper or on the computer. It helps me focus. It helps me stay connected and on track with God. It reduces the distractions and the tendency for my mind to wander. I have file cabinets filled with Prayer Journals written in spiral notebooks and computer files with Prayer Journals written in Word documents.



The one thing that always fuels my faith is reading God's Word. I always ask the Holy Spirit to continue speaking to my heart and spirit through His Word. I read five chapters of scripture every day. One chapter from the next book in the Old Testament, the next Psalm, the chapter in Proverbs that matches the date, the next chapter in the Gospels, and the next chapter in the New Testament. As the Holy Spirit speaks to my heart, I stop and write or type those verses into my Prayer Journal. It takes some time to do this, but I find it to be a helpful way of getting God's Word into my heart. I can also go back anytime to be reminded of what the Holy Spirit was saying to me. It is the most powerful and consistent way I have found to fuel my faith in any circumstance or situation. Here is an example from my Prayer Journal.

TAG Thursday 5-7-2020 7:11AM

Joshua 1:1-9 *After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, "Moses my servant is dead. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all*

this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel. Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given to you, just as I promised to Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun shall be your territory. No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you or forsake you. Be strong and courageous, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go. (ESV)

Psalm 46:1-3 *God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. (ESV)*

Proverbs 7:1-3 *My son, keep my words and treasure up my commandments with you; keep my commandments and live; keep my teaching as the apple of your eye; bind them on your fingers; write them on the tablet of your heart. (ESV)*

Luke 10:1-2 *After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of him, two by two, into every town and place where he himself was about to go. And he said to them, "the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. (ESV)*

Revelation 1:9 *I, John, your brother and your partner in the tribulation and the kingdom and the patient endurance that are in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos on account of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus. (ESV)*
